C.G. Jung offers a different approach, one that engages and integrates the richness and complexity of the unconscious, and in doing so brings to our lives depth, nuance, meaning, and individuality. He suggests that instead of trying to solve our problems, we might outgrow them. What does this mean, and how can we go about it? This workshop will explore these questions. We’ll unpack some key ideas from Jung by drawing on poetry, film, comics, music, photography, and more. We’ll then engage in individual reflection, group discussion, and meaningful ritual to experience how this approach can touch and enrich our everyday lives.

You will be headed to 5990 Old West Saanich Road, the corUnum Yurt. Be mindful of the Sparton intersection if you are coming from Victoria. You will want to turn left there and then immediately right to STAY on Old West Saanich Road. Keep going until you see Killdeer Road (keep left) and turn there. You will see 5990 on your left, but proceed and turn into the second entrance, also on your left. Park in the area marked with red balloons and walk up the path to the right. The path will also be marked with balloons. When it forks, stay left and head into the yurt. We will meet you there!
